

# PARKING IN BRN0 FROM 30. 9. 2019



The parking system has become more structured from September 30, 2019, with only three visitor zones with scaled parking fees. The system is easy to use for visitors. The closer to the center you are, the more you pay for parking your vehicle.

Current rules remain the same for residents and subscribers, with some benefits, such as lower prices for additional vehicles.



#### Why is the parking system changing?

During regular operation, some shortcomings of the existing system have become apparent, and these shortcomings needed to be dealt with. The crucial point has been to make the whole parking system simpler. At the same time, comments raised by the users of the system have been taken into account to improve it.



#### Key changes in the parking system:

- ▶ Division into Visitor zones A (red), B (green) and C (blue)
- ➤ Zones A and B will be regulated day and night, while in Zone C the regulation will apply only overnight (from 5 pm till 6 am).
- ▶ The regulation applies only on business days
- ► Additional parking hours for residents' visitors (in Zone A/B, 200 hours of free parking with the option to buy additional 100 hours)
- ▶ Discounted parking for subscribers (1 car for CZK 4000 per year, each additional car for CZK 18,000 per year)
- ▶ Visitor subscription for Zone B, suitable for employees, releasing them from the duty to pay for parking every day. The price is CZK 400 per week / CZK 1,200 per month / CZK 12,000 per year. Valid only for Zone B from 6am till 5 pm.
- ▶ The extension of the permit for severe health disability card holders enables them to park 3 hours every day FREE OF CHARGE in each zone.
- ▶ Change for motorcycles: in the regulated zones, i.e. in the zones with parking fees, motorcycles can be parked free of charge. However, a permit must be arranged in advance. The procedure is similar to the one currently applicable to cars, but the permit is not related to the place of residence, only to the registration plate of the motorcycle.

# I'M A RESIDENT

- ▶ Physical person with permanent residence within the designated area (temporary residence for international citizens)
- ▶ An owner of a real property in the designated area
- ▶ The parking permit is valid not only the area of permanent residence, but also in all neighbouring areas (with the exception of area 1-01). In all other parking areas, residents are regarded as visitors.

# WHAT DO I NEED TO GET THE PARKING PERMIT?

- ▶ Proof of permanent residence or ownership of property (ID document or excerpt from the Cadastre of Real Estate)
- ▶ Proof of legal relationship to the car (e.g. registration certificate)
- ▶ Payment of fee for parking authorisation

# I'M A SUBSCRIBER

- ▶ Self-employed physical person or legal person with registered address within the designated area
- ▶ Self-employed physical person or legal person with place of business within the designated area
- ▶ The parking permit is valid not only in the area of registered address, but also in neighbouring areas (with the exception of area 1-01). In all other parking areas, the persons mentioned above are regarded as visitors.

# WHAT DO I NEED TO GET THE PARKING PERMIT?

- ▶ Proof of the existence of a head office or workplace (extract from the commercial register)
- ▶ Proof of legal relationship to the car (e.g. registration certificate)
- ▶ Payment of fee for parking authorisation

# I'M A VISITO


- lacktriangle The parking system is divided into three visitor zones (A red, B green, C blue)
- ▶ The closer to the city centre, the higher the parking fee
- ▶ Payment for parking can be made using a mobile app or parking machines or via SMS (starting from autumn 2019)
- ► A resident may grant free parking hours to visitors who come to visit him/her
- ▶ Pre-paid parking permit may be obtained for Zone B. Such a permit is valid on business days from 6 am till 5 pm and costs CZK 400 / week, CZK 1,200 per month, or CZK 12,000 per year

### **RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

#### From September 30th, 2019



The new parking system will be effective in the following areas: 1-01, 1-13, 1-14, 1-02.

#### From November 18th, 2019



The new parking system will be effective in the following areas: 1-12, 1-11, 1-04, 1-03.

#### From Spring 2020



The new parking system will gradually take effect in other areas.

Areas marked in light green (1-15, 1-10 and 1-09) will therefore be included gradually and will belong to Zone B (green).

#### The "flower" principle

The areas designated with thick black line are governed by the "flower" principle.

## **VISITOR ZONES**



#### Zone A (RED)

historic city center / vehicle entry permit is necessary / regulation applies around the clock / 30 minutes of free parking a day / CZK 40 per each additional hour



#### Zone B (GREEN)

a ring around the historic city centre / regulation around the clock / 60 minutes of free parking a day / CZK 30 for each additional hour



#### Zone C (BLUI

rest of the city / regulation only overnight from 5 pm till 6 am / 60 minutes of free parking a day, then CZK 20 per each additional hour

Regulation only applies on business days



- **▶ LIMITED ENTRY (WITH PERMIT** ONLY)
- ▶ valid around the clock on business days
- ▶ the first 30 minutes FOR FREE
- ▶ then CZK 40 / hour

- **► ANYONE CAN PARK IN ZONE B**
- ▶ valid around the clock on business days
- ▶ the first 60 minutes FOR FREE
- ▶ then CZK 30 / hour

- **▶ ZONE C NO REGULATION DURING THE DAY**
- valid from 7pm till 6 am on business days
- ▶ the first 60 minutes FOR FREE
- ▶ then CZK 20 / hour

# WHAT ARE VISITOR ZONES A, B AND C?

- ▶ Zone A: historic city center where vehicle entry permit is necessary / regulation applies around the clock / 30 minutes of free parking a day, then CZK 40 per each additional hour
- ▶ Zone B: a ring around the historic city centre / regulation around the clock / 60 minutes of free parking a day, then CZK 30 for each additional hour
- ▶ Zone C: rest of the city / regulation only overnight from 5 pm till 6 am / 60 minutes of free park-ing a day, then CZK 20 per each additional hour
- ► Regulation only applies on business days
- ▶ At weekends and on holidays, parking is FREE OF CHARGE all day long and no registration is required



# INFORMATION FOR FOREIGNERS

A. Proof of permanent residence or the ownership of real estate in the Residential Area

Proof of permanent residence - persons who are not citizens of the Czech Republic (foreigners) and are also citizens of the EU:

- ▶ travel document and one of the following documents:
  - permanent residence card
  - certificate of temporary residence of foreigners in the Czech Republic

Proof of permanent residence - persons who are not citizens of the Czech Republic (foreigners) and are also not citizens of the EU:

▶ travel document and residence permit card issued for foreigners with permanent residence for the Czech Republic

#### Proof of ownership rights to real estate in the Residential Area

- ▶ citizenship card or travel document and
- extract from the Cadastre of Real Estate proving that the claimant owns real estate in the Residential Area
- B. Proof of legal relationship to the vehicle (vehicles)
- ▶ Owner or operator of the vehicle

With the vehicle registration document or the vehicle registration certificate.

User of a vehicle based on leasing or long-term rental

With the vehicle registration document or the vehicle registration certificate, with the lease or rental contract, the certificate of business authorisation of the lessor in the field of leasing and lending of movable property.

▶ User of a vehicle based on a contract with a credit provider when buying a vehicle on a loan

With the vehicle registration document or the vehicle registration certificate, loan contract and (if necessary) a related contract, from which it follows that the claimant has the right to use the vehicle, the certificate of business authorisation for the credit provider in the field of providing loans.

User of a vehicle based on the entrusting of the vehicle by the employer for the personal use of the claimant

With the vehicle registration document or the vehicle registration certificate, an affidavit from the employer concerning the existence of a labour-law relationship between the employer and the claimant as an employee and concerning the entrusting of the vehicle to the claimant.

▶ User of a vehicle based on the entrusting of the vehicle as a member of an elected authority of a legal entity (without an employment contract)

With the vehicle registration document or the vehicle registration certificate, the affidavit by the legal entity proving that the claimant is a member of an elected authority of this legal entity, provided the legal entity is registered in the public register kept in accordance with the rule of law of the Czech Republic, with an extract from the public register proving the existence of this legal entity, or another document proving the existence of such legal entity.
